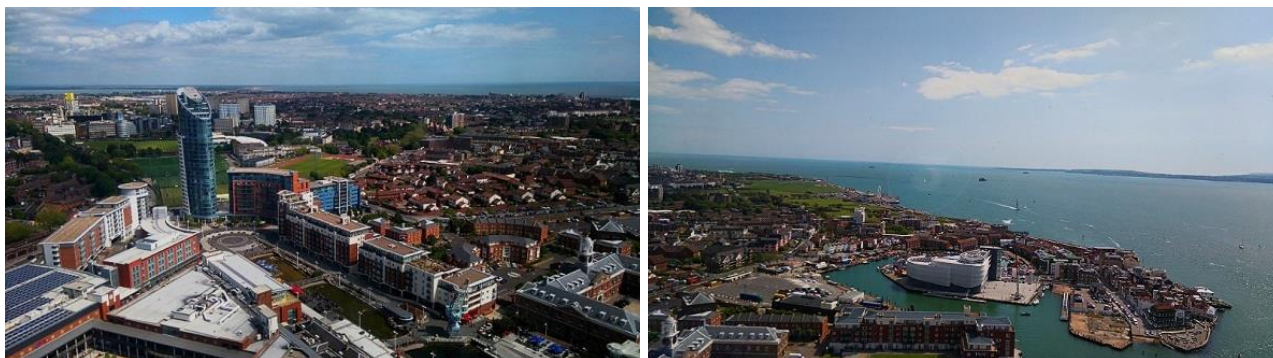


ERASMUS+ cooperation project with English city Portsmouth

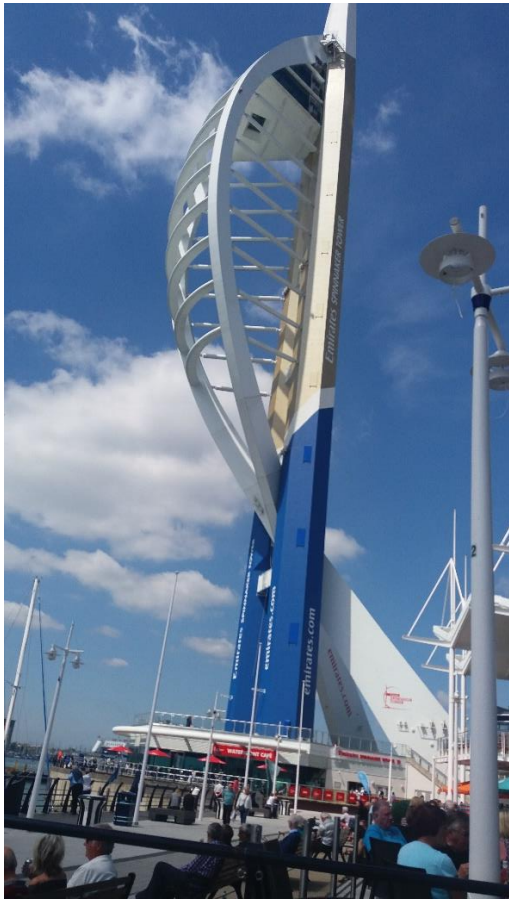
From 15th May to 28th May 2016 4 catering sector students and 2 teachers within Erasmus+ project worked and studied in the Portsmouth catering enterprises.
